Every decision maker has the right to decision quality, achieved through:



A **decision frame** that structures the decision in the most relevant context.



Creative alternatives that enable a selection among viable and distinct choices.



Relevant and reliable information upon which to base a decision, incorporating the inherent uncertainty.



An understanding of **potential outcomes** of each alternative described in terms of the decision makers' values.



Sound reasoning and analysis that allow decision makers to draw meaningful conclusions and choose the best alternative.



An effective decision project leader to achieve alignment and commitment to the best action.
